# **Primary Care Transformation**




### Triple Aim

- Better Care
- Improved clinical patient outcomes
- Increased system efficiencies
- Better experience for teams and patients
- Focus on outcomes and performance measurement

# Opportunities – cont.



#### **Better Outcomes**

Less persistent / serious MH conditions

80% better functioning in early identification for depression

# Better Experience for Patients & HCP

Ability to monitor conditions over time

Team based care – improved satisfaction for patients & HCP's

### How?



- 4 to 6 yr. old immunization focus on parent child relationship, behavioural issues, healthy lifestyle issues
- Teen immunization dep/anx screening (GAD 2 & PHQ-2)
- Ask the adults who you are seeing for MH issues how the children are doing?
- Screen all children & teens of parents with anxiety and/or depression

# **Challenges**



- C&YMH needs to be integral part of the "medical home"
